Program at a Glance

K and 1 st grade	Full Chinese immersion in core subjects
2 nd grade	Begin formal English instruction 7 periods per week
3 rd grade	6 periods of English per week
4 th -8 th grade	5 periods of English per week
5 th grade and above	Different levels of Chinese and Math classes 5 th grade70% Chinese : 30% English 6 th and 7 th grade—60% Chinese: 40 % English 8 th grade50% of instructional time in Chinese; 50% of instructional time in English






Preparing Parents for English Learning in an Immersion Setting

(1) Research indicates that —during the first few years students' English learning may be behind that of their monolingual peers; by fifth grade, the immersion students should catch up, or be at a higher proficiency level than their monolingual peers.


MCA Reading Scores in 3rd and 5th Grades

MCA Reading Scores All Grades





Preparing Parents for English Learning in an Immersion Setting (2) Be patient with children's progress in learning English.


