## Distinguished world leaders Ban Ki-moon and Julia Gillard To Speak At Asia Society Hong Kong Center Gala Dinner "Navigating the Future: The Road Ahead"

(Hong Kong, December 13, 2017) – Asia Society Hong Kong Center ("ASHK") today announced that it will be hosting its gala dinner on **December 14, 2017 (Thursday)** on the theme of "**Navigating the Future: The Road Ahead"**. The gala dinner will feature **Ban Ki-moon**, 8th secretary general of the United Nations, and **Julia Gillard**, former prime minister of Australia and chair of the Global Partnership for Education, who will be engaged in a keynote conversation moderated by **Ronnie C. Chan**, Chairman Emeritus of Asia Society and Chairman of Asia Society Hong Kong Center, on the challenges and opportunities faced by the global community in 2018 and beyond.

One of Hong Kong's annual signature events, the ASHK fund-raising gala dinner will focus on the theme of "Navigating the Future: The Road Ahead". The featured keynote conversation will touch on topics especially on the global work to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals championed by Secretary-General Ban and developed and agreed during his tenure, and the concerted efforts being made by Julia Gillard and the Global Partnership for Education to advance education in some of the most challenging environments in the world. Proceeds from the evening will contribute significantly to supporting ASHK's critical mission of delivering education about the countries and cultures of Asia and global issues that impact the region.
